Bronze Level:

To qualify for the Bronze level, a unit must meet one of the following: Earn a Bronze rating in every objective, or accumulate at least 1400 points, with points earned in no fewer than seven (7) objectives.

Silver Level:

To qualify for the Silver level, a unit must meet one of the following: Earn a Silver rating in every objective, or accumulate at least 1800 points, with points earned in no fewer than nine (9) objectives.

Gold Level:

To qualify for the Gold level, a unit must meet one of the following: Earn a Gold rating in every objective, or accumulate at least 2200 points, with points earned in no fewer than eleven (11) objectives.
