Bronze Level:

To qualify for the Bronze level, a unit must meet one of the following: Earn a Bronze rating in every objective, or accumulate at least 1600 points, with points earned in no fewer than Eight (8) objectives.

Silver Level:

To qualify for the Silver level, a unit must meet one of the following: Earn a Silver rating in every objective, or accumulate at least 2000 points, with points earned in no fewer than ten (10) objectives.

Gold Level:

To qualify for the Gold level, a unit must meet one of the following: Earn a Gold rating in every objective, or accumulate at least 2600 points, with points earned in no fewer than Twelve (12) objectives.
